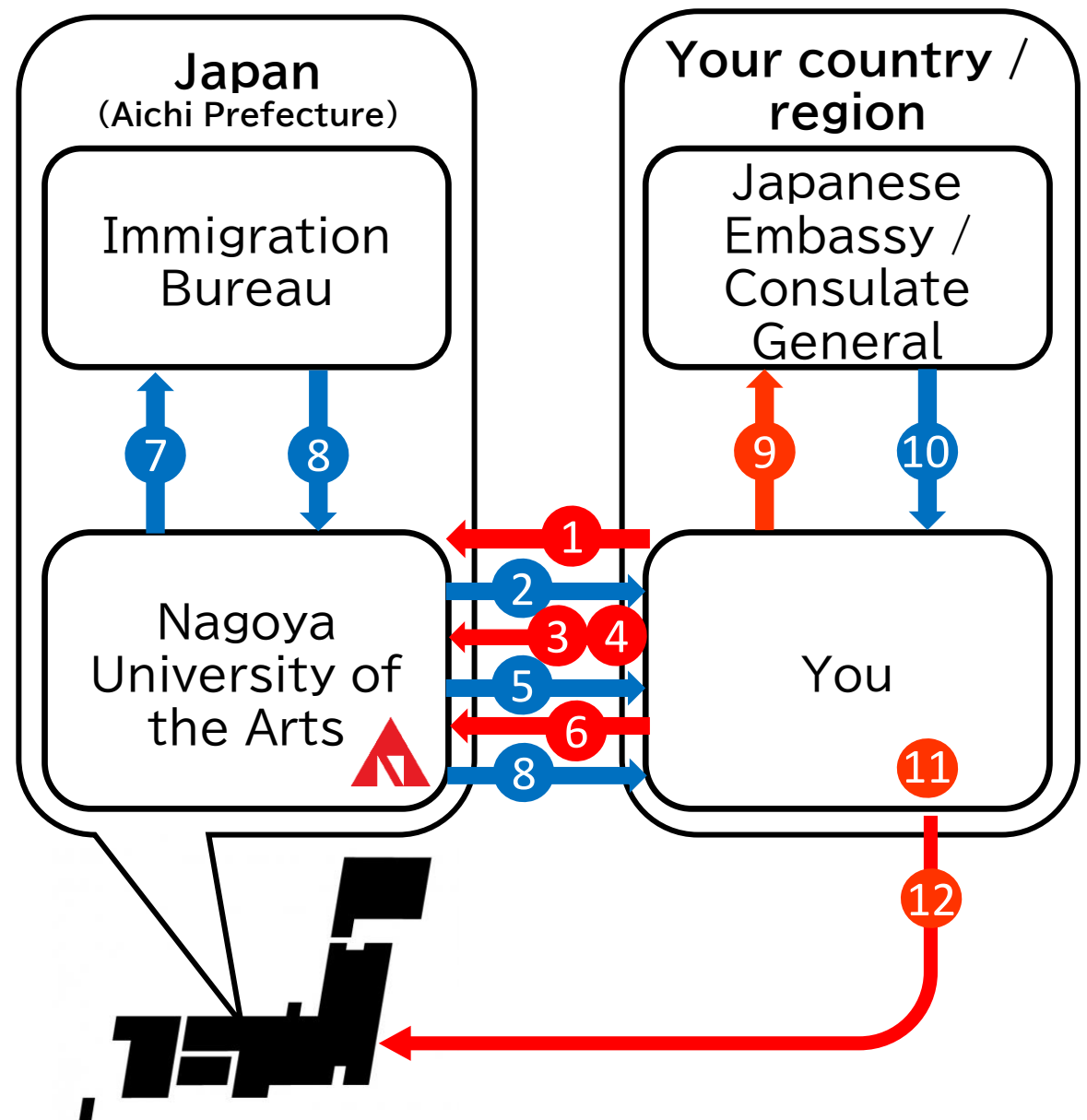


[Reference] Application and Immigration Procedures

To enter Japan for studying abroad, you are required to obtain a "Student" visa. Following is the general description of application and immigration procedures.

- ① Submission of pre-examination documents
- ↓
- ② Permission for Application
- ↓
- ③ Application
- ↓
- ④ Entrance exam
- ↓
- ⑤ Admission
(NUA will send you "Certificate of Passing" and an application form for "Application for Certificate of Eligibility")
- ↓
- ⑥ Fill out and submit the application form for "Application for Certificate of Eligibility" to NUA
- ↓
- ⑦ NUA will submit your Application for Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) to Nagoya Regional Immigration Bureau as your representative.
- ⑧ CoE is normally issued within 1-3 months.
- ↓
- ⑧ Issuance of CoE: NUA will send your CoE as soon as it has been issued by the immigration bureau.
- ↓
- ⑨ Apply for a "Student" visa at the nearest Japanese embassy or consulate general in your home country/region.
- ⑩ Visa is normally issued within 5 business days.

- ⑩ Issuance of Visa

- ⑪ Book your flight(s) and make arrangements for accommodation. ※1

- ⑫ Travel to Japan ※2



About CoE:

CoE is a official certificate, certifying that you have been accredited you to be eligible for the status of residence, "Student," by Japanese Minister of Justice. By submitting CoE upon application for Visa and application for landing, examinations for these applications shall be performed smoothly.
